

Your healthcare provider has decided to use urine to test you for some infections. Please use the following instructions to collect the urine correctly:

- 1 You should have not urinated for at least one hour prior.
 - 2 Do not wipe or clean the outside of your vagina (the labia) before you urinate.
- 3 Sitting on the toilet, urinate into the cup. The urine that first comes out of your body is needed.
- 4 Check to see if the bottom of the cup is covered. If so, this is about 2 ounces. Do not urinate anymore into the cup, as too much urine can make it hard to see if an infection is there.
 - After collection, empty your bladder in the toilet.
 - Mark the cup with your name.
- 7 Wash your hands.





First Catch Urine Collection Instructions for Men
